

SUB-ZERO AWARD

What is it?

The Sub-Zero Award is available to any registered Scout or Explorer and their leaders who wish to demonstrate outstanding camping knowledge and abilities by camping out in weather zero degrees or below.

Specific Requirements:

1. Open only to regularly organized patrols, troops, or Explorer posts and their leaders.
2. Temperature at some point during the 18-hour campout must go to zero degrees Fahrenheit or below.
3. At least two meals must be cooked (pre-prepared foods may not be used). Dehydrated or freeze-dried foods are recommended.
4. Everyone including leaders must carry in one trip all food, shelter and equipment used in the campout. Hike needs to be at least 1.5 miles one way.
5. Each unit leader must be responsible for proper instruction and training of all boys and leaders prior to the sub-zero campout.
6. A complete report must be filled out as soon as possible after completion in order to purchase patches.
